

Save Our Brains Materials List

Below is a list of materials needed for the Save the Rainforest project based unit. We have inserted the links to the exact item and where you can purchase them online knowing that many of these items are things you may already have in your classroom.

Item	Quantity per pack	Each student needs...	Notes
Glue	30	1 per every 3-4 students	Some students will use glue for their final graphic design poster. Any kind of glue will work for this project.
Scissors	12	1 per every 3-4 students	Ideally each student will have a pair of scissors. If students work at their own pace, they will not all need a scissor at the same time.
Tape	6 rolls	Each student will need 3-5 pieces of tape	One class should be able to share a few rolls of tape.
Rulers	48	Each pair or small group needs one ruler	Students will use rulers with a center groove. The groove is used to roll marbles.
Marbles	500	Each student or pair of students needs 4 marbles	Marbles should be small enough to roll in the central groove on a ruler.
Colored Paper	100	TBD	If students choose to make a graphic design poster form a collage, they will need paper to cut out for their project. Any colored paper will suffice.
Pens or Pencils	N/A	1 per student	Any pen or pencil will suffice.
Markers or Colored Pencils	N/A	Enough for each student	Students will use markers and colored pencils for their graphic design poster and scientific illustrations. Any coloring tools will suffice.
Pennies	N/A	4-5 pennies per student	Each student will need a few pennies.
Nickles	N/A	1 per student	Students will select coins from a bag. The bag contains pennies and one nickel.
Paper bag	N/A	1 per pair	Any small bag that kids can't see through and that students can stick their hand inside will do.
Poster Paper	N/A	1 per student	Each student will create one poster. This can be a poster paper of 11x17 paper.
