

TP.6 Outline

Directions It's time to outline your graphic design poster. Make sure your poster includes:

1. A clear focal point.
2. Colors and font that matches the tone of your message.
3. A clear action you want people to take.

Two choices: You have two choices for how you create your graphic design poster.

- **Option 1: Drawing.** You can design and draw the whole poster yourself. Pick your colors, draw your poster.
- **Option 2: Paper Cut-Out Art:** You can make a poster using paper cut-out art. This is when you cut out shapes and art work and glue them on to your poster. You can write your own letters or cut them out of a magazine. The next three pages have different shapes and drawings you can use.
