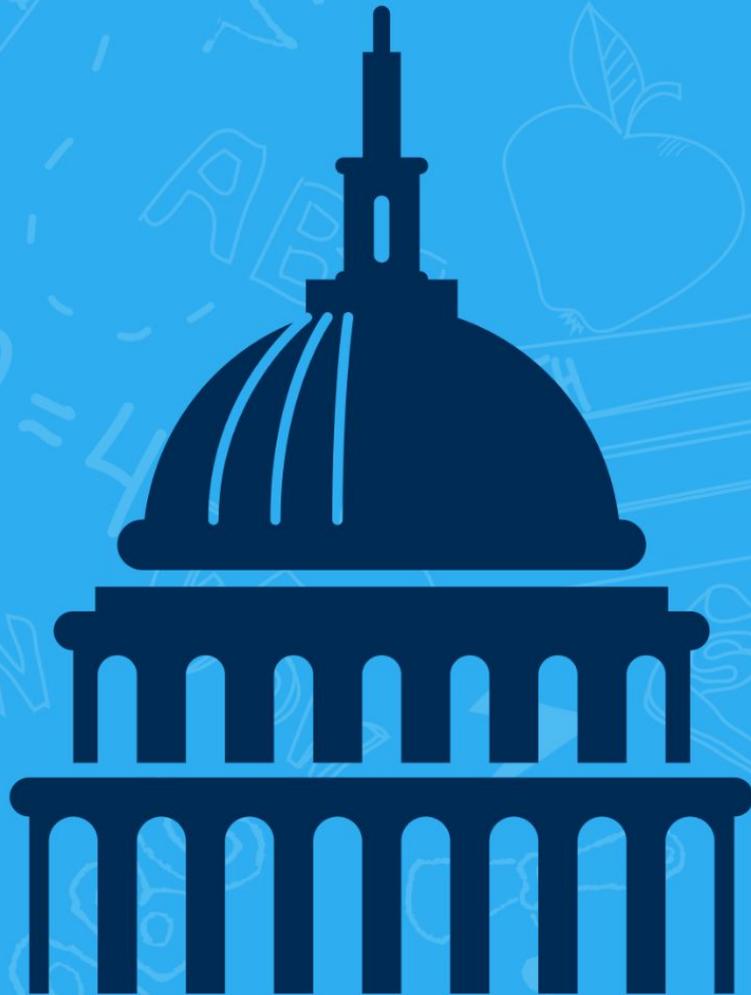

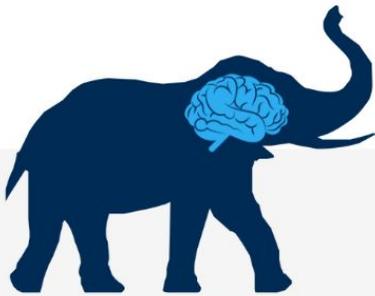

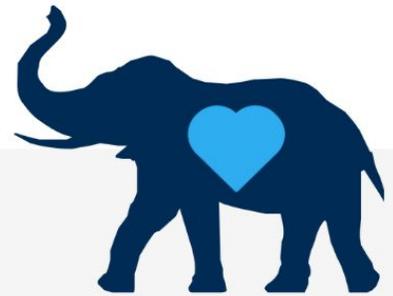
A.3 Head and Heart

2. Heart: Then make a list of facts that will make people have empathy for elephants. Write those in the heart column.



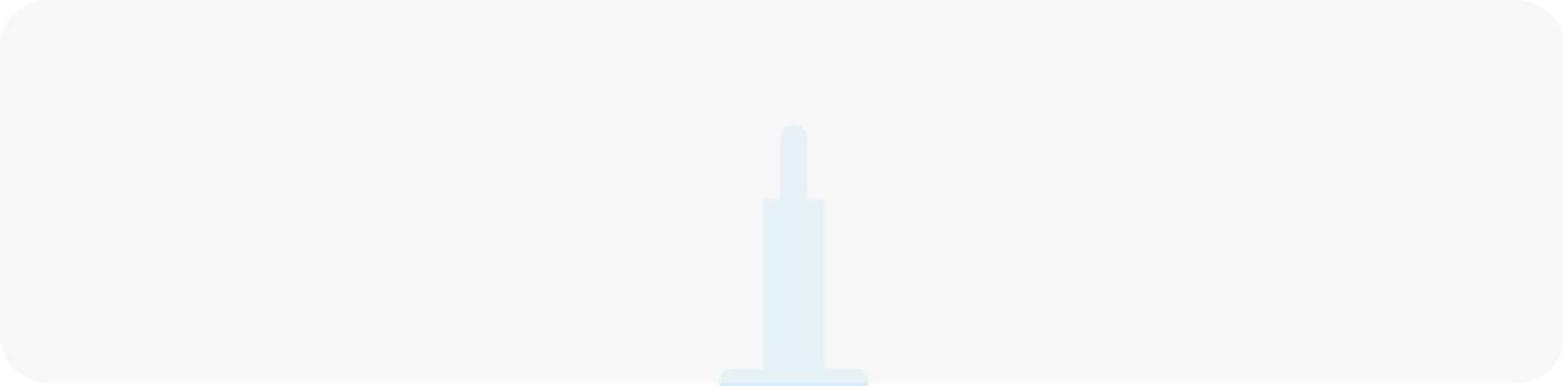

Questions:

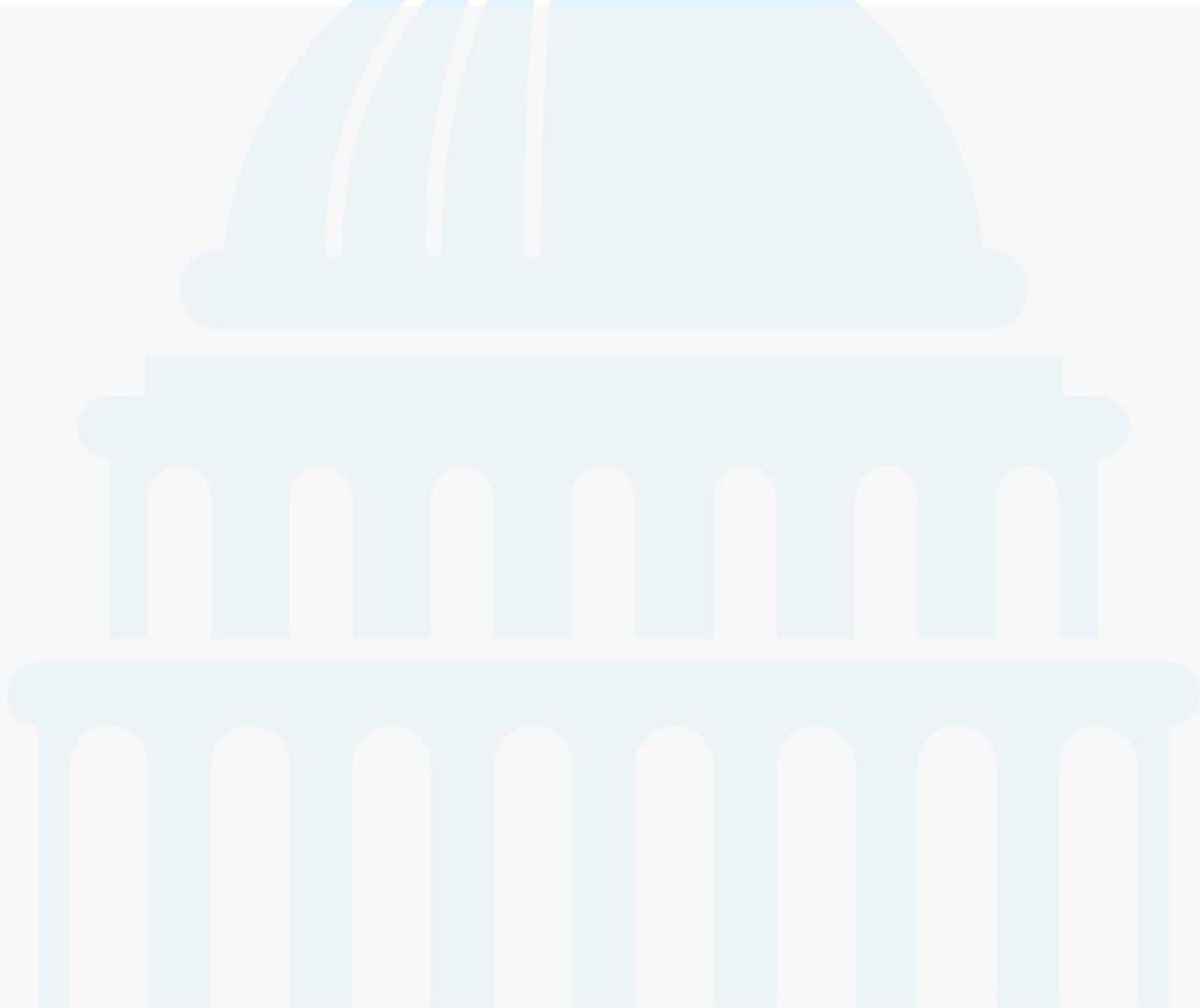
1. Do I have a clear Ask? Does my Congressperson know what I want them to do?
