Below is a list of materials needed for the Stop the Spread project-based unit. We have inserted the links to the exact item and where you can purchase them online knowing that many of these items are things you may already have in your home, school or classroom.

Item	Quantity per pack	Each student / group needs...	Notes
glitter	N/A	2-3 different-colored bottles to share	Students will pour glitter on their hands for the Glitter Challenge. Students can share glitter bottles, but it will work well to have at least a couple different colors.
hand soap	N/A	1 bottle to share	Students will need to use hand soap at the end of the Great Glitter Challenge. Students can share.
Paper or labels	N/A	1 piece of paper, or 10 labels, per student	Students will need to label their vector models. They can use any type of paper or use pre-made labels.
markers or other coloring tools	N/A	1 set to share	Any coloring tools (colored pencils, crayons, markers) will work for this project. Students can share.
tag board or construction paper	N/A	2 per student	Each student will need a couple pieces of tagboard or construction paper for their Disease Personality Cards.
scissors	N/A	1	Student scissors will work well to cut out the Disease Personality Cards. Students can share.
poster board	N/A	1	Students will each need 1 piece of poster board for their Then and Now Weather Report. Large pieces of construction paper would also work.
Modeling Clay (or other preferred materials)	N/A	1-2 pieces per student	Students will make a model tick. Modeling clay works well. However, students are welcome to use any material they choose. Playdough, pipe cleaners, paper mache, or cardboard would also work well.
